As a California-based public benefit organization with 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status, our mission is to provide personalized medical and therapeutic support to children living with disabilities and their families, particularly those from underserved communities facing economic barriers. We recognize the difficulties that arise when health insurance denies coverage, and our foundation exists to bridge that gap. When families lack the necessary resources to support their child's recovery, we are here to help. From therapy and prosthetics to home modifications and medical devices, our foundation is just one click away, ready to provide the assistance they need.

How We Help

We support children living with conditions such as cerebral palsy, autism, rare genetic disorders, epilepsy, and more. Caring for children with disabilities often involves significant expenses for specialized medical care, therapies, medications, and equipment. ***In the U.S., these families typically face annual healthcare costs ranging from \$10,000 to over \$50,000.*** We provide funding for medical services that would otherwise be financially out of reach for families. Our goal is to help as many families as possible receive the aid they deserve by creating individualized funding plans based on their needs.

OUR PROGRAMS



Therapy For Kids Program

Our foundation supports and coordinates a wide range of therapies, including physical therapy, occupational therapy, hippotherapy, speech therapy, swim therapy, psychotherapy, and more. Each child undergoes an individualized assessment, and a tailored therapy plan is developed to meet their specific needs. The funding and duration of therapy vary for each child based on their unique circumstances.



Medical Device Program

We provide funding for essential medical devices such as prosthetics, assistive technology, and specialized walkers that are often not covered by insurance. These devices help children overcome their challenges and improve their quality of life.



Handicap Accessibilities Program

We help ease the challenges faced by children with disabilities by funding accessibility equipment, including wheelchairs, vans, scooters, stairlifts, ramps, ADA-compliant bathrooms, and transfer systems.

Ensure that everyone, regardless of their social and economic status, has access to equal medical resources.

Help families in need by bridging the gap between health insurance and the extra medical care they cannot afford.

At MPFC, we were founded with a clear purpose: to bridge the financial gaps in healthcare costs that insurance companies often overlook. We understand that the families who seek our help have exhausted every financial resource available to them. **The cost of caring for a child with disabilities or severe injuries from birth to 18 years old is estimated to range between \$1.4 million to \$2.4 million, or even higher.** As the only organization in the United States dedicated to addressing this critical need, the number of applications we receive continues to grow.

While our programs are designed to scale and adapt to meet this increasing demand, our waiting list is also steadily rising. This is why we depend on the support and generosity of organizations like yours. MPFC is actively seeking partners who share our belief that no child should be left without access to the best medical care.

Together, we have the power to transform the lives of children living with disabilities and their families, giving them hope as well as opportunities to gain independence, improve social skills and enjoy their lives to the fullest.

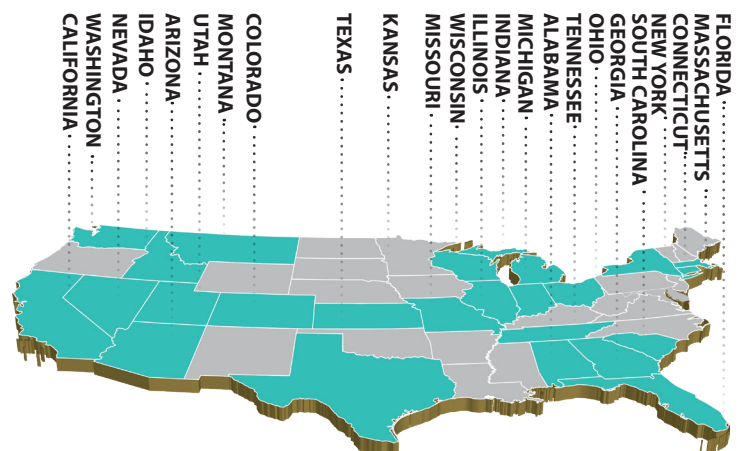
